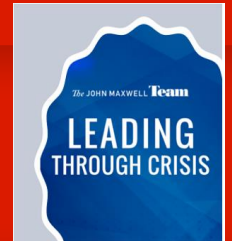



a time of intense difficulty, trouble, or danger.

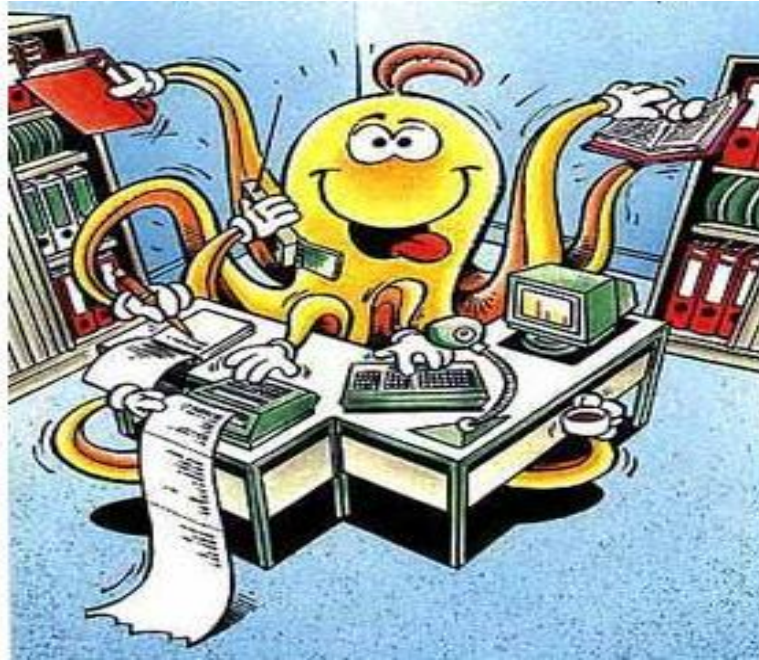
a time when a difficult or important decision must be made.

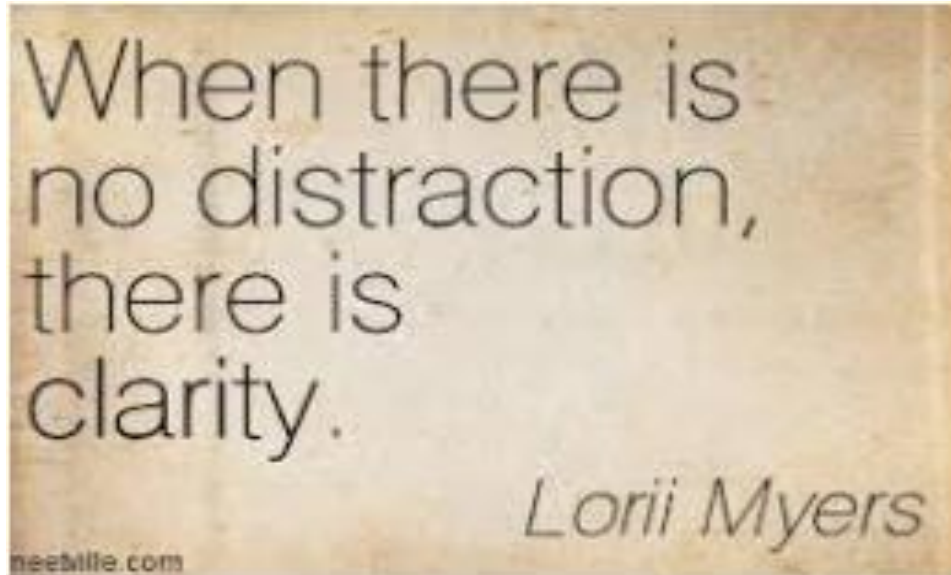

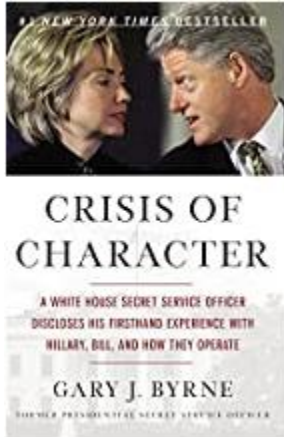

Measures success through growth & development.

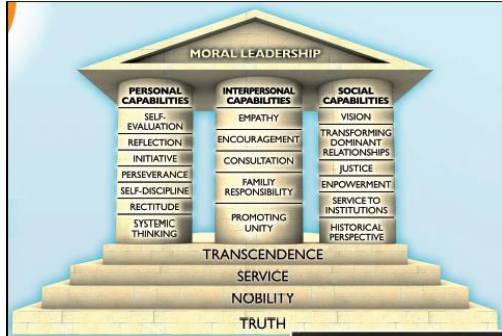
