TRADE AND INVESTMENT STATISTICS

Exports are a Vital Part of Illinois' Economy^A

- Preliminary Illinois exports totaled over \$80.82 billion in 2024, a 2.5% increase from 2023, and a 35.2% increase from 2019. The preliminary agricultural adjusted figure for 2024 is \$81.97 billion, a 0.9% increase from 2023 and a 32.2% increase from 2019.
- Illinois is the largest exporting state in the Midwest and the 4th largest in the nation, using agricultural adjusted figures provided by Census Bureau/USDA cash receipts.
- 13 out of top 20 export industries increased since 2023.
- 18 out of top 20 export industries increased since 2019.
- 12 of the top 20 Illinois export partner countries have seen gains since 2023.
- 19 of the top 20 Illinois export partner countries have seen gains since 2019.
- Export activities support over 800K jobs in Illinois.^B

Total Trade between Illinois and Chile in 2024

- Illinois exports to Chile totaled \$978.1 million in 2024, a 3.8% decrease from 2023 and a 38.5% increase since 2019. Chile is Illinois' 15th largest export market.
- Illinois ranks 5th among the 50 U.S. states in exports to Chile.
- Illinois imports from Chile totaled over \$191.0 million in 2024, a 13.6% decrease from 2023 and a 11.2% decrease since 2019. Chile is Illinois' 41st largest import market.
- Illinois ranks 12th among the 50 U.S. states in imports from Chile.

Chilean Foreign Direct Investment in Illinois^D

- Illinois ranks #2 in the nation and Chicago ranks #1 amongst largest metro areas for new and expanding corporate locations.
- Illinois is home to over 2,682 foreign firms with unique 11,232 locations that employ more than 552,695 Illinois residents.
- Chilean firms employ 264 Illinoisans at 9 distinct locations for 3 subsidiaries.
- Chile is Illinois' 38th largest FDI partner by employment.
