#### TRADE AND INVESTMENT STATISTICS

#### Exports are a Vital Part of Illinois' Economy<sup>A</sup>

- Preliminary Illinois exports totaled over \$80.82 billion in 2024, a 2.5% increase from 2023, and a 35.2% increase from 2019. The preliminary agricultural adjusted figure for 2024 is \$81.97 billion, a 0.9% increase from 2023 and a 32.2% increase from 2019.
- Illinois is the largest exporting state in the Midwest and the 4th largest in the nation, using agricultural adjusted figures provided by Census Bureau/USDA cash receipts.<sup>c</sup>
- 13 out of top 20 export industries increased since 2023.
- 18 out of top 20 export industries increased since 2019.
- 12 of the top 20 Illinois export partner countries have seen gains since 2023.
- 19 of the top 20 Illinois export partner countries have seen gains since 2019.
- Export activities support over 800K jobs in Illinois.<sup>B</sup>

#### **Total Trade between Illinois and South Korea in 2024**

- Illinois exports to South Korea totaled \$1.43 billion in 2024, a 1.4% increase from 2023 and a 29.2% increase from 2019. South Korea is Illinois' 11th largest export market.
- Illinois ranks 7th among the 50 U.S. states in exports to South Korea.
- Illinois imports from South Korea totaled \$3.34 billion in 2024, a 11.8% decrease from 2023 and a 4.7% increase since 2019. South Korea is Illinois' 13th largest import market.
- Illinois ranks 8th among the 50 U.S. states in imports from South Korea.

- Illinois is home to over 2,682 foreign firms with unique 11,232 locations that employ more than 552,695 Illinois residents.
- South Korean firms employ 4,372 Illinoisans at 122 distinct locations for 53 subsidiaries.
- South Korea is Illinois' 18th largest FDI partner by employment.
