## Medication Abortion Services

Medication abortion is a safe, effective, and non-surgical way to end an early pregnancy using FDA-approved medications: mifepristone followed by misoprostol. The process begins in a clinical setting and can be completed in the privacy of your home, with support and guidance from our trained healthcare team.

### Who can access these services?

- Currently enrolled SIUE students that are up to 9 weeks pregnant (verified by clinical exam or ultrasound)
- Individuals seeking a safe, private, and supported option

### What to expect:

#### 1. Initial Consultation

You'll meet with a licensed healthcare provider to discuss your options, confirm pregnancy, and review your health history.

#### 2. Informed Consent & Instructions

Receive detailed information about the process, potential side effects, aftercare, and support options. Consent forms will be completed.

#### 3. Medication Dispensing

The prescription for Mifepristone and Misoprostol may be filled at the SIUE Campus Pharmacy.

- Depending on your situation, you may take the first pill at home or under clinical supervision.
- Our team will work with you to find the safest and most affordable option for your situation.
- If you prefer, you may use another registered pharmacy in Illinois. Visit [FDA's REMS-certified pharmacy list](#) or contact our clinic staff for guidance.

#### 4. Follow-Up Care

A follow-up check (via phone, virtual, or in-person) will ensure the process is complete and you're healing well. Support is always available.

## Cost and Insurance

- The initial medical consultation with an SIUE provider is fully covered by the Student Health Fee. There is no additional charge for this visit if you are a currently enrolled student.
- The cost for both mifepristone and misoprostol typically ranges from \$56.00 to \$64.00 from SIUE Pharmacy. Prices are subject to change.
- SIUE Health Service and Campus Pharmacy do not bill insurance directly, but students may submit receipts for potential reimbursement.
- If cost is a concern, we can refer you to community-based programs or providers that offer financial assistance or services on a sliding scale.
