COURSE DESCRIPTION

Day one:: Dr. Ivan Valcarenghi will present a course that provides a foundation sleep dental medicine in general practice. He will show how he works with physicians and other health care professionals in the diagnosis, evaluation and treatment of sleep disorders. He will have a hands-on portion that have attendees participate in several cases for diagnosis and treatment planning of sleep disorders.. Also included in his presentation, Dr. Valcarenghi will talk about sleep tests, the principles of case selection and appliances.

Day Two: Dr. Kirk Noraian will begin with the foundation of doing a comprehensive exam that guides periodontal treatment. He will present the spectrum of treatment options such as nonsurgical therapies to regenerate concepts to make decisions about what to treat, when to refer and how to maintain long-term success. To bring this course to "life", the participation portion will include technologies like lasers, Guided Biofilm Therapy (GBT) implant placement and piezosurgery. The participation portion will offer firsthand tools and techniques in your office to help elevate your treatment of periodontal disease..


