What are pre-qualified and excluded experiences?

To qualify as community service for the JH Scholarship, an experience must meet ALL qualification specifications and must not be excluded, per the “Qualified and Excluded Experiences” section of the *JHS Student Guide* on the [JHS Website](#).

To assist scholarship recipients, lists of pre-qualified and excluded experiences are included in this catalog.

- **Pre-qualified experiences** have been reviewed by the Kimmel Belonging and Engagement Hub and meet the community service specifications.
- **Excluded experiences** do **NOT** meet the community service expectations and will **NOT** receive final approval.

Scholarship recipients are responsible for ascertaining whether or not an experience qualifies as community service for the JH Scholarship. Final approval decisions will not be made on the basis of a recipient’s lack of awareness or misunderstanding of qualification and exclusion specifications and/or failure to adequately research experiences prior to committing to and/or participating in the experience.
