- 1. Cover Letter (single spaced) explaining why you are interested in a graduate assistantship, any experiences you have had that will help you be successful in the position of a graduate assistant in the Program, and what you hope to gain from this experience. Information related to ability to take direction, previous paid public health work experience, teaching-related experiences, conducting research, and/or working in a collaborative environment is of particular interest.

- 4. Contact information of two references including name, title, organization, email, and phone number
