Online Registration

HOW TO CREATE AN ACCOUNT AND REGISTER FOR ONLINE SERVICES AND EDUCATIONAL OUTREACH PROGRAMS

1. Create an account.

If this is your first time registering for a membership, trip or non-credit course online, you must create an account.

- Go to: https://www.enrole.com/siue/
- Click on "Sign In/Create Acct" in the left navigation menu.
- Select "Create Account" and proceed to enter your information.
- Be sure to select "Yes" to receive emails and mailings from us with information about upcoming programs.
- Also, you will want to select "Individuals" before clicking "Submit" at the bottom of the page.

2. Add items to your cart.

After you have created an account or logged in, use the navigation on the left to select which category/courses/memberships/trips you want to add to your cart. Once you find the item you want to add, click "Add to Cart."

- If your course is hosted on the SIUE Edwardsville campus, there
 may be parking charges included. Select "Registration Fee –
 Without Parking," if you either would not like to pay for a parking
 pass or are associated with the University and have a University
 hang tag. Select "Registration Fee Parking Included" if you would
 like to obtain a parking pass for the duration of the offering.
- From here you may either continue shopping or check out. If you are registering for a course that requires a promo code, you may enter it on this screen. Follow the prompts on the subsequent screens.

3. Completing your registration.

In your shopping cart, you should see your name under "Attendee List" and under the item(s) for which you are registering.

- If there is more than one member of your household attending, you may register both people for the event at the same time by clicking "Add Another Attendee" at the bottom of the page.
- You may also add additional programs and register for all the programs in which you are interested at once. Clicking "Submit Order," you will be redirected to the CashNet payment portal.
- Please enter your credit card information to complete your registration and click "Continue Checkout" at the bottom of the page.
- You will be redirected to a review page where you can review your order before finally submitting your order.
- Your order is not placed until you finalize your registration and are taken to a page with "Thank you. Your order has been placed." at the top of the page.







From grant-writing to writing your own screenplay, or from hair care to healthcare, learn a new skill this summer at the SIUE Belleville campus, located at 2300 W. Main Street (Old Main Hall), Belleville.

Grant Writing and Management for Public Agencies and Non-Profits

From finding the right Notice Of Funding Opportunities through closing out awards, this course will familiarize you with the grant process. Writing grant proposals in the public and non-profit world can be a daunting task but is increasingly important to secure operational funds and ensure organizational continuity. While the course focuses primarily on federal grants, we will also discuss other types of grants and how they may differ from federal programs. This course will provide insight and tips into the three main components of grants. Upon completion of the course students should have a better insight in how to target specific grant programs, develop a solid proposal, and have better expectations about post-award grant management.

Heartsaver® CPR/AED Certification

No medical training? No problem! Heartsaver® courses are designed for anyone willing to learn first-aid basics for the most common first-aid emergencies. You will receive hands-on training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and learn to use an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) in a safe, timely, and effective manner. Upon course completion, you will receive a two-year certification card.

Trauma-related deaths account for approximately 40% of fatalities worldwide, with severe bleeding being a leading cause. Time is critical, as someone experiencing severe bleeding can succumb in as little as five minutes. This training course emphasizes the urgent need for bleeding control to preserve life by containing blood loss. The course follows OSHA guidelines and covers bleeding control techniques like identifying types, applying pressure, wound packaging, and using a tourniquet. Upon course completion and passing the final exam, you will receive a printable completion certificate.

Course Fee: Free Wednesday, 9:30-10:30 a.m., July 30 SIUE Belleville Campus

Release and Restore Full Moon Sound Restorative

This 90-minute course begins with gentle breath and movement to relieve discomfort in the body, remove unwanted thoughts from the mind, and release unpleasant emotions from the soul. It will flow into a deeply relaxing resting yoga session accompanied by healing sound vibrations from metal and crystal bowls, a gong, chimes, a drum, and a native flute to restore the body, mind, and spirit to a state of health and well-being.

CAREERS IN WATER TREATMENT TECHNOLOGY SIUE ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES TRAINING CENTER

Water Quality Control Operations Program

Program Cost: \$9,900 siue.edu/ertc

PROGRAM

The SIUE Environmental Resources Training Center (ERTC) Water Quality Control Operations Program is a one-year, full-time program of study leading to a certificate of completion. Classes meet Tuesday-Friday for nine months starting in mid-August each year. During the summer, students complete a 10-week internship program where they work five weeks at a drinking water treatment plant and five weeks at a wastewater treatment plant.

Upon completion of the full-year program, students are qualified to enter the water and wastewater industry as water operators, wastewater operators, distribution/collection workers, laboratory technicians, or maintenance workers all for less than \$10,000.

FACILITIES

The ERTC facility provides students with two fully equipped wet chemistry teaching labs, classrooms, auditorium, library/computer center, 30,000 gallon/day training-scale drinking water and wastewater treatment plant, and the 0.5 million gallon/day SIUE University wastewater treatment plant.

CERTIFICATIONS

Students are eligible to take Illinois and Missouri certification exams to become certified as drinking water and wastewater operators-in-training. Upon completion of the ERTC program, graduates are eligible for full certification.

Intermediate Italian

If you already have knowledge of this beautiful language, this course is designed just for you! Join us as we continue our journey through learning the Italian language and delve deeper into grammar and syntax. To succeed in the course, a basic knowledge of Italian language will be needed.

Spanish Grammar in Depth: Intermediate Level

Grasp some of the most challenging topics in Spanish such as direct and indirect object pronouns, reflexive verbs, stem-changing verbs, and the uses of "ser" and "estar." All grammar topics will be studied in the present tense. However, once you understand the grammar rules, you can apply them to the other tenses.

Conversational Spanish: Beginners 2 Level

This class is ideal for those who have taken the introductory level courses or who have previous knowledge of the language and wish to develop better conversational skills. Join us as we journey deeper through the Spanish language. We will focus on live conversations in class. Written exercises and audios will be given as homework.

Course Fee: \$109 Thursdays, 6-8 p.m., June 5-July 31 (no class July 3) Online via Zoom

Conversational Spanish: Beginners 3 Level

This course allows students to complete the beginner's level and is also an introduction to advanced-level concepts. As with the previous course, this focuses on live in-class conversations, while students continue to build vocabulary and grammar skills by working on written exercises and audios for homework.



Yoga and Breath Work

Breathing, like movement, is so fundamental to human experience that we rarely even think about our breath. However, mindful movements and breath work, or intentional practices of breathing and moving, can deeply increase our quality of life. This class unites the art of mindful movement and breath work with practices in diverse breath work techniques and movements inspired by gentle yoga, Tai Chi, qi qong and more. Instructor: Louise M. Hamlin-Laird, E-RYT 200, E-RYT 500, YACEP.

Course Fee: \$80 for 10-week session Drop-ins welcome at \$15 per session Thursdays, 11:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m., June 5-Aug. 7 Online via Zoom

Sit to Stand - Chair Yoga

Chair yoga is a gentle form of yoga in which poses are performed while seated and with the aid of a chair. This yoga is suitable for all levels of abilities; standing is optional. It is an excellent class for beginners, seniors, individuals with recent injuries, balance or coordination issues, limited mobility and disabilities, and those who have difficulty or do not want to get up and down on the floor. Chair yoga helps reduce stress while increasing flexibility, range of motion, circulation and strength, balance and coordination, and lung capacity. This class incorporates breathing exercises, simple visual meditation techniques, gentle stretching, easy yoga postures, and a final relaxation.

Wisdom Qigong Meditation

Wisdom Qigong Meditation is a practice that benefits one's physical, mental, and emotional well-being. Qi, pronounced "chee," is our life energy and gong means "to cultivate." Using a holistic and systematic approach to enhance our qi, we deepen the unified connection of our physical, emotional, and mental aspects of ourselves. This is done by learning and practicing specific chanting practices and guided silent meditations. Deeper body, mind, and emotional connection created via Wisdom Qigong is beneficial in areas of balanced emotions, focus, sleep, pain management, and mental endurance.

NEW! Introduction to Woodblock Printmakina

This course will introduce you to woodblock printmaking. You will become familiar with the tools, the carving process, and inking and printing techniques. Students will learn about paper and will tear their sheets to size. We will use both a wooden spoon and an etching press to print our editions. Each student can expect to take home at least 10-15 prints by the final class.

Ms. Ruthie will teach students how to create a ceramic berry bowl/small colander to enjoy all the delicious berries summer has to offer. Understanding Debits and Credits

In this course, you will learn about the accounting equation and the five categories involved in every business: assets, liabilities, owner's equity, revenue, and expenses. Every financial transaction falls into one or more of these categories. Learn how to create a chart of accounts that meet the needs of your business. You will learn how double entry bookkeeping works and the process of recording debits and credits. This course will show you how to identify, analyze and record transactions using journal entries under the cash basis accounting method.

General Ledger and Month End Procedures

In this course, you will learn how to post journal entries to the correct general ledger accounts impacted by each transaction. This course will show you how to make sure your general ledger balances at the end of each month by preparing an unadjusted trial balance. You will learn how to look for errors when you don't balance and how to determine to correct entries. After posting correcting entries and/or adjusting entries, you will verify debits and credits equal with an adjusted trial balance. This course also goes through the steps of performing monthly bank reconciliations.


Unemployed? Underemployed?
