SIUE Gateway Opportunity (SIUE GO) Terms and Conditions, 2025-2026

Award Details

The SIUE Gateway Opportunity (GO) Grant is for qualifying Missouri students who reside in St. Louis City or one of the following Greater St. Louis counties: Franklin, Jefferson, Lincoln, St. Charles, St. Louis, and Warren. The Grant is valid for fall and spring semesters and will be continued, if renewal conditions are met, for eight semesters across four academic years, as funds are available. This grant will be applied toward tuition and fees. The SIUE Commitment will cover any gap that remains after utilizing financial aid from all tuition-targeted federal, institutional and private sources, including merit-based scholarships.

The award will be credited to the student's university account each semester and can be used in an SIUE professional program, at the undergraduate rate of tuition. By accepting this grant as part of the financial aid offer, the student agrees to the terms and conditions of the grant detailed herein. Financial aid offers can be accessed through the student's CougarNet account.

SIUE GO in Combination with Other Awards and Financial Aid

The SIUE GO Grant will be applied to tuition and fee charges on the student's account. SIUE GO Grants will be considered awards to meet financial need in the packaging of financial aid. The Grant will be applied after financial aid from all tuition-targeted federal, institutional, and private sources, including merit-based scholarships. The SIUE GO Grant is not refundable to the student.

Academic Performance and Student Conduct

Continuance or renewal of the grant requires completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each year to demonstrate need with a family income less than \$113,575 and assets less than \$50,000. To continue to receive the SIUE GO Grant, the student must remain a Missouri resident, enroll in at least 12 credit hours each term, and maintain a cumulative SIUE GPA of 2.0 or higher.

In addition to the renewal requirements for the award, the student must also abide by the University academic policy as stated in the catalog and student handbook at www.siue.edu/registrar, the Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy for financial aid and scholarship recipients at www.siue.edu/financialaid, and the Student Conduct Code at www.siue.edu/POLICIES.

Award recipients should keep address changes up to date with the University and must check SIUE email often for important announcements.

Awarding Criteria

- Incoming dependent freshmen or transfer students with family income less than \$113,575 and assets less than \$50,000 based on submitted Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). SIUE code: 001759.
- Must be a Missouri resident who attended a Missouri high school.
- Must be enrolled full-time in a bachelor's program. The award is valid for eight semesters. Pharmacy students may be eligible at the undergraduate rate.
