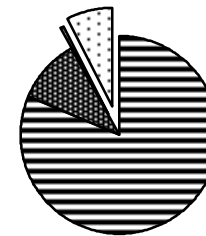

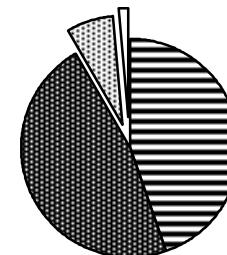

Job Satisfaction of Ten-Years Out Alumni



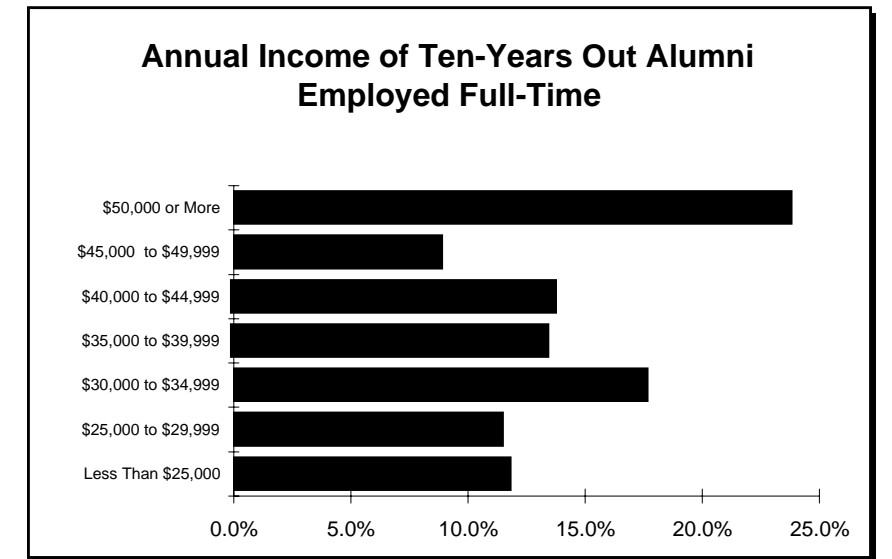
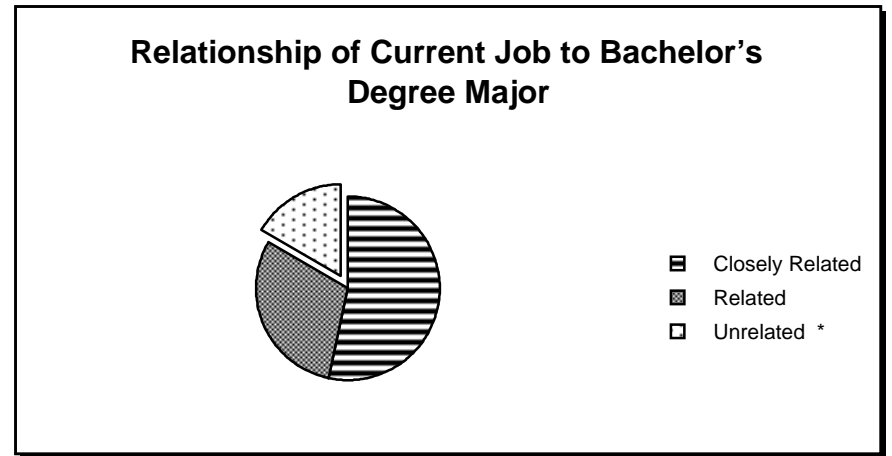

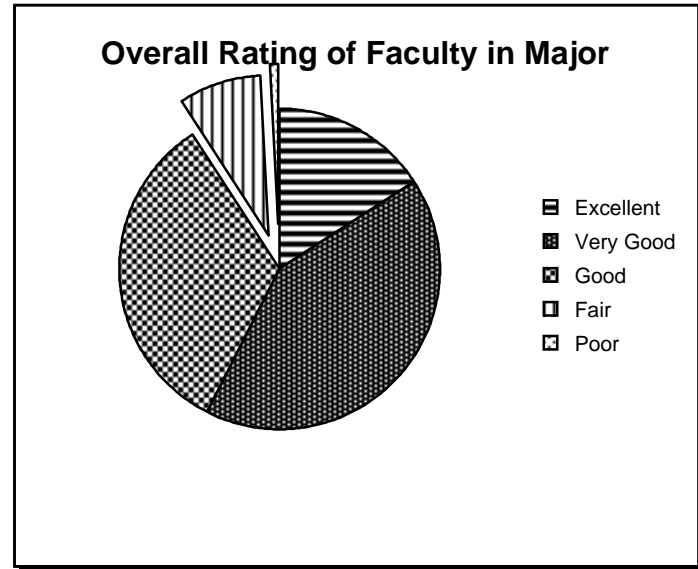

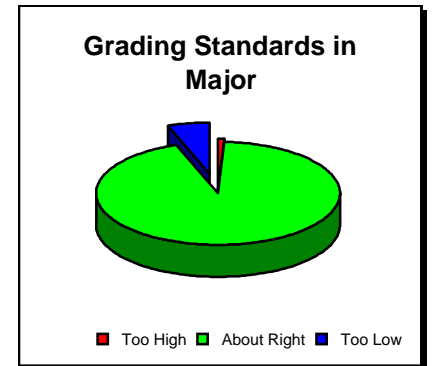
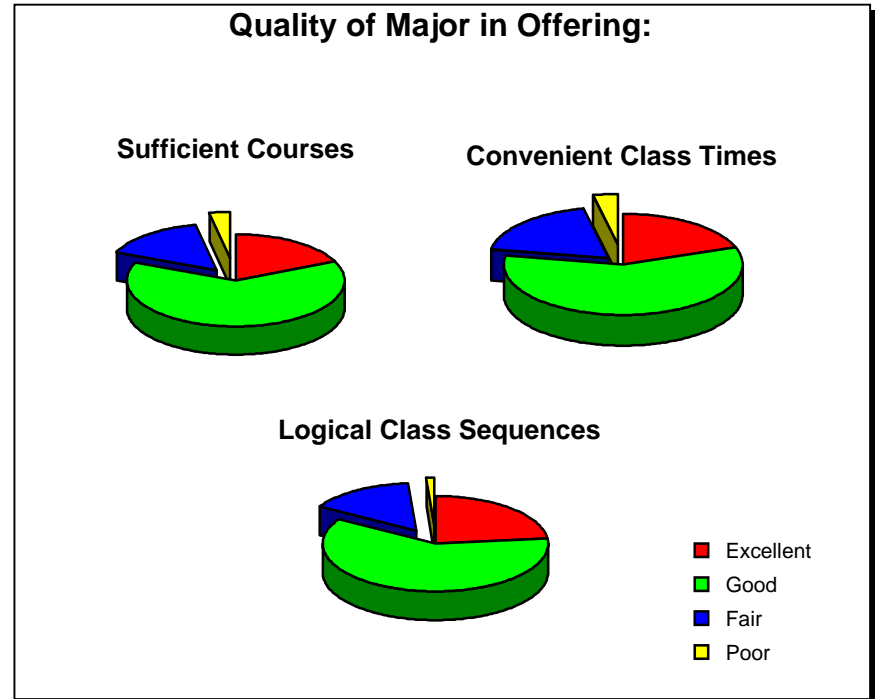


Advisors in Major Were Usually Available When Needed



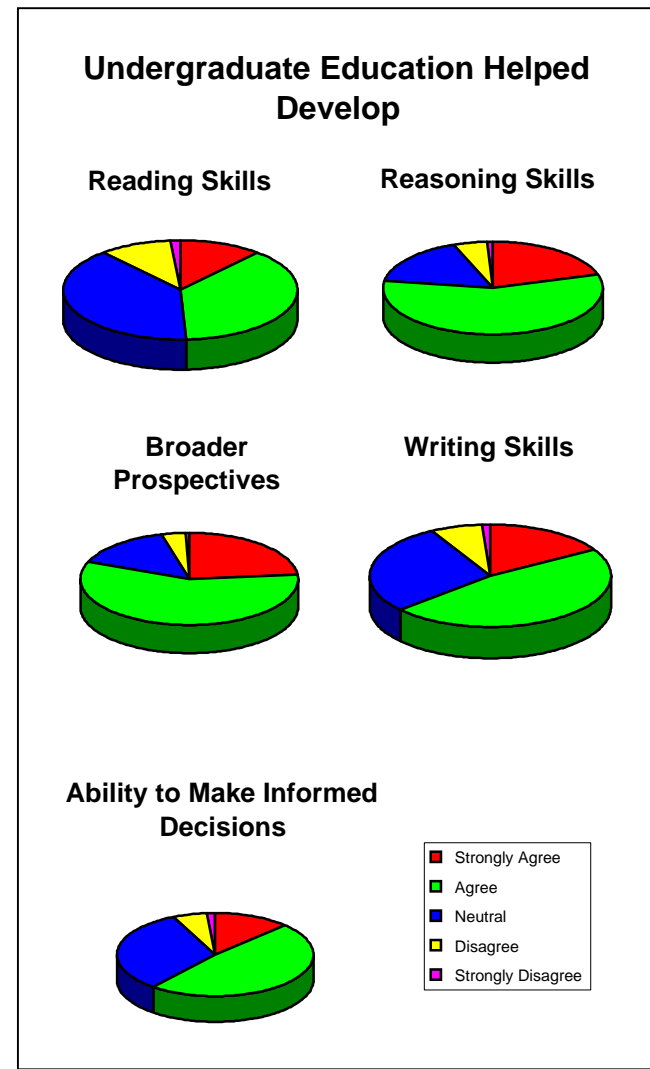
