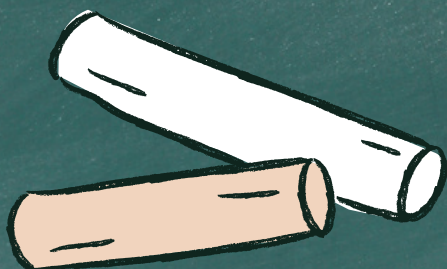

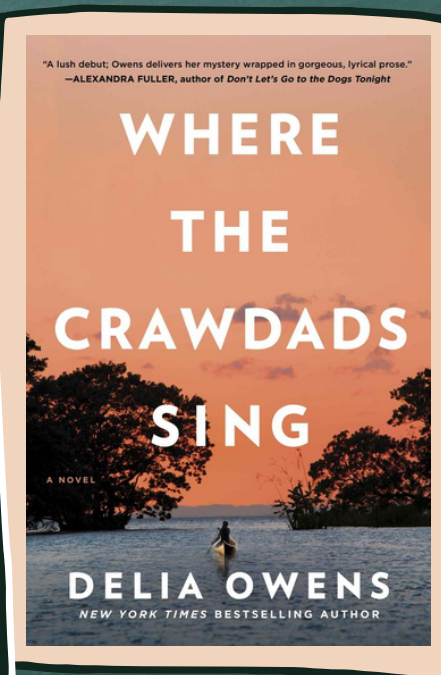
## What can the LRC do for you?
