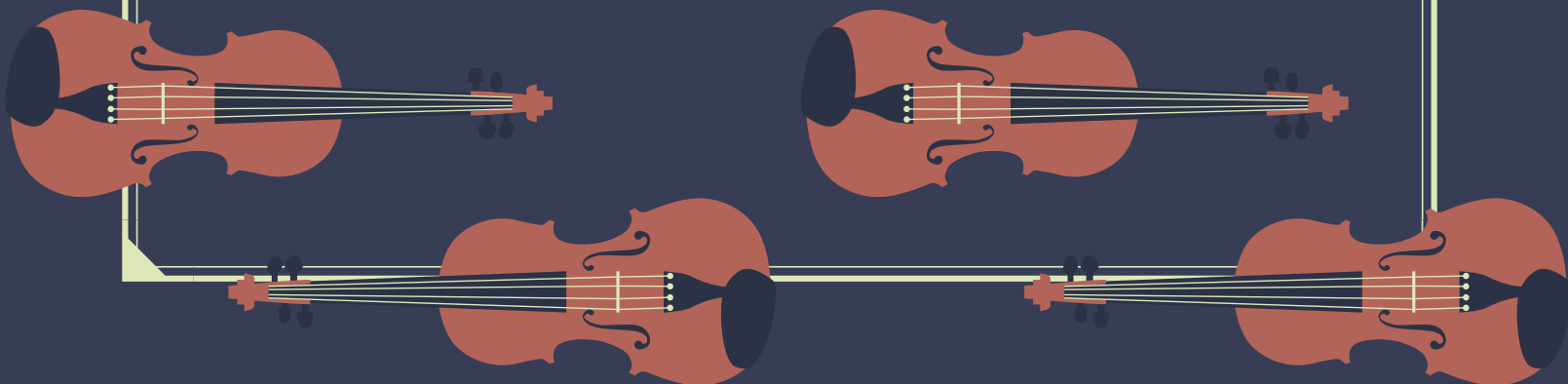

Our Concerto Competition Winners

Clara Johnson, Intermediate Division

Clara Johnson is 14 years old and in 8th grade at Lincoln Middle School. She has been playing the violin for 11 years under the instruction of Mrs. Vicki Lottes. In 2015 she moved to Sioux City, Iowa where she studied at various studios including the Sioux City Conservatory of Music. In 2017 she returned to the SIUE Suzuki Program in Edwardsville. She currently enjoys playing in the Advanced Chamber Ensemble and the Suzuki Tour Group. Clara went on her first tour to Czech Republic and Poland with the Suzuki Tour Group in 2023 and will be going on the next tour in 2025. She has attended The American Suzuki Institute for 5 years and various Suzuki workshops. Outside of music, Clara runs cross country where she was a state qualifier this year, she has been part of a robotics team for 3 years, and enjoys her friends, crafts, shopping, and her dog Max. Clara is grateful for all her music teachers both past and present and the support of her family. She would especially like to thank Mrs. Vicki Lottes for her excellent teaching and mentorship. Kaitlyn Foppe, Advanced Division

Kaitlyn Foppe is a junior at Father McGivney Catholic High School and a dedicated violin student. She began studying violin at age seven with Erika Lord-Castillo, and continues her studies under her mentorship. Kaitlyn is a 2023-24 ILMEA All-State violinist, the winner of the 2022 and 2024 Advanced Division John and Kay Kendall Concerto Competition, and the co-principal violinist of the 2024 ILMEA All-District Orchestra. In addition to her solo and ensemble work, Kaitlyn plays with the SIUE Suzuki Tour Group, having toured the Czech Republic and Poland, performed with the Town and Country Symphony, and volunteered at the SIUE Suzuki Strings Summer Camp. She has also studied piano for nine years, earning eight superior ratings and two gold cups in National Federation of Music Clubs Festivals. In 2024, she won the district piano solo competition at the Missouri Federation of Music Clubs' District IV Virtuoso Club Festival and went on to compete at the MFMC State competition. This year, Kaitlyn was selected as the 2024-2025 Cathedral Basilica of Saint Louis Organ Scholar, where she studies pipe organ and choral conducting, plays at and assists with Masses and rehearsals, and serves under the Cathedral's music directors. Outside of music, Kaitlyn enjoys spending time with family and friends and reading books. She is deeply grateful to her parents, Katie and Patrick Foppe, and her teachers—Erika Lord-Castillo, Allison Woerner, Jennifer Harkey, Andrew Kreigh, and Danielle Boulanger—for their unwavering support and encouragement, which have been instrumental in her growth both as a musician and an individual.

The Ensembles

Advanced Chamber Ensemble (ACE), Edwardsville Youth Orchestra (EYO), Edwardsville String Ensemble (ESE), and Beginning Orchestra (of Awesomeness) (BOA) are string ensembles that rehearse weekly on Saturday mornings and perform music representing a variety of styles and genres. ACE is our most advanced orchestra, EYO consists of intermediate to advanced players, and ESE's players have a minimum of one year playing experience. Beginning Orchestra is our first reading orchestra and is the first orchestral experience for most of its members.

SIUE Violin Tour Group, Viola Camerata, and Cello Ensemble offer advanced string players an opportunity to perform in an ensemble whose main focus is excellence in performance and educational outreach. The groups have performed across the U.S., Sweden, England, Scotland, France, Austria, the Czech Republic, Italy, Spain, Ireland, Germany, Switzerland, Latvia, Lithuania, Estonia, and Poland.
