College of Lake County - Transfer Planning Guide – Criminal Justice MAJOR

Criminal Justice Studies

Transfer students who have attempted at least 30 semester hours in courses at accredited institutions will be automatically admitted to SIUE and eligible for Direct Entry to Criminal Justice Studies in the College of Arts & Sciences, provided they have earned a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA (4.0 scale) in coursework at the previous accredited school(s) attended.

Transfer students who have attempted fewer than 30 semester hours in courses at accredited institutions must meet transfer admission criteria AND first-time freshman criteria to be automatically admitted to SIUE and eligible for Direct Entry to Criminal Justice Studies in the College of Arts & Sciences.

It is recommended that students complete the AA or AS degree with the following course selections:

***Bolded** courses in parentheses are the SIUE equivalent to the College of Lake County Course. Minimum GPA of 2.00 required. Students must receive a 'C' or higher in all criminal justice course work for SIUE graduation requirements.

SIUE Foundations Courses:

15 credit hours

- * ENG 121 (**ENG 101**)
- * ENG 122 (**ENG 102**)
- * CMM 111 (**ACS 103**), or CMM 121 (**ACS 101**)
- * PHI 122 (**RA 101**) – **waived with an AA or AS degree**
- * MATH 140 (**QR 101**) – **waived with an AA or AS degree.**

SIUE Life & Physical Sciences

7 credit hours

Life Science course - SIUE will accept most any Life Science course.
Physical Science course – SIUE will accept most any Physical Science course.
Either the Life or Physical Science course must include a Lab.
See [SIUE Course Equivalency Guide](#) for additional options. Choose BLS or BPS under the attribute section. EL will designate the Lab component

SIUE Fine & Performing Arts & Humanities: 6 credit hours

Any one Fine Arts course and one Humanities course for students receiving an AS or AA.
An additional Fine Arts or Humanities course for students receiving an AA.

SIUE Social Sciences:

9 credit hours

- * SOC 121 (**SOC 111**), ANT 221 (**ANTH 111B**),
- * PSC 121 (**POLS 112**)

SIUE Info & Comm in Society

3 credit hours

BICS course - SIUE will accept most any BICS course.
See [SIUE Course Equivalency Guide](#) for additional options.

Criminal Justice requirements:

- * CRJ 121 (**CJ 111**), CRJ 124 (**CJ 202**), CRJ 123 (**CJ 273**), CRJ 221 (**CJ 206**)
- Students must receive a 'C' or higher in all criminal justice course work.

SIUE Health requirement:

- * Any EH (Experience Health) attribute equivalent course. – **waived with an AA or AS degree.**
