Lincoln Land Community College Associate of Arts Accounting

Completion of an Associate in Arts or Science degree at Lincoln Land Community College fulfills SIUE's general education requirements with the exception of an Interdisciplinary Studies course that all students must take during their junior or senior year at SIUE.

This "Transfer Program Guide" is an **example** of proposed curriculum for students to use while completing their associate's degree. Reading, writing, and math placement could alter the course sequencing and transfer date. Therefore, students should begin sequencing their reading/writing (if applicable) and math & science courses during the first semester, paying particular attention to prerequisites. Students have the option of taking summer classes to lessen fall and spring course loads.

It is highly recommended that students meet with a Lincoln Land College advisor; for additional information please contact the SIUE coordinator for advising and partnership programs.

STUDENTS MUST BE ACCEPTED TO SIUE PRIOR TO ADMISSION INTO THE PROGRAM.

ADDITIONAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS/INFORMATION

For all applicants, Seven Prerequisite courses (C or higher required in each course) EGL 101, EGL 102, CMN 101/104, ECO 131 ECO 132, MAT 113, CSC 105 (Accounting majors need a "B" or higher in ACC 103. MAT 131 (Calculus) or higher-level mathematics is allowed in place of MAT 130. Math 141 MAT 130, ACC 103 are required, but are not prerequisites. Students should be encouraged to complete MAT 141.

Transfer students who have attempted at least 30 semester hours in courses at accredited institutions will be automatically admitted to SIUE and eligible for Direct Entry to the School of Business provided they have earned a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA (4.0 scale) in coursework at the previous accredited school(s) attended.

Transfer students who have attempted fewer than 30 semester hours in courses at accredited institutions must meet transfer admission criteria AND first-time freshmen criteria to be automatically admitted to SIUE and eligible for Direct Entry to the School of Business

Students must have a 2.25 GPA to apply (2.5 GPA for Accounting). The GPA is determined by all college level coursework taken at all higher education institutions.
