Please contact the SEHHB Advising Office for more information about the program application. Phone: 618.650.3940 Students must be admitted to SIUE prior to submitting an application to the School of Education, Health, and Human Behavior.

In order to be admitted to a teacher education cohort in early childhood education, it is necessary to have:

- *A cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher at all institutions and be in good academic standing at SIUE
- *Completion of 42 semester hours or more of college-level coursework
- *Received a grade of C or better in ENG 101
- *A course that satisfies both the ERGU and EREG requirement will only be counted as one and not both.

During the Fall 2 semester, please contact SIUE Early Childhood Advisor, Jennifer Cummings, at jecummi@siue.edu in order to start preparing your school of education application. Applications are due by **February 1st** for a Fall start. The application process is competitive and a limited number of spaces are available each semester. All other applications will be accepted on a rolling basis after the priority deadline until capacity is
