The application process is competitive and a limited number of spaces are available each semester.

All other applications will be accepted on a rolling basis after the priority deadline until capacity is met.

The program eligibility requirements are as follows:

- *Students must be admitted to SIUE prior to submitting an application to the School of Education, Health, and Human Behavior.
- *Received a grade of C or better in ENG 101 and ED 255, Intro to Education.
- *Combined GPA (all post-secondary work) of 2.5 or higher.
- *Good academic standing at SIUE (if applicable).
- *Completion of 42 semester hours or more of college level course work.

*A course that satisfies both the ERGU and EREG requirement will only be counted as one and not both.
