Southwestern Illinois College Transfer Planning Guide – Traditional Transfer Option

Admission Requirements

Southwestern Illinois College Course

- Admission to the University (requires submission of a University application and \$40 fee)
- Transfer students who have attempted at least 30 semester hours in courses will be automatically admitted to SIUE and eligible for Direct Entry to the Nursing major provided they have earned a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA (4.0 scale) in coursework at the previous accredited school(s) attended.
- Transfer students who have attempted fewer than 30 semester hours in courses must meet transfer admission criteria AND first-time freshmen criteria to be automatically admitted to SIUE and eligible for Direct Entry to the Nursing major.

The following is a list of courses Southwestern Illinois College students should take while preparing to transfer to SIUE. These courses *should* be completed prior to matriculating to SIUE and *must* be completed with a grade of 'C' or higher to be eligible to enroll in SIUE Nursing courses. Students not completing these courses prior to transferring will be required to complete them at SIUE prior to enrolling in Nursing courses.

Note: BIOL 158 (although not a prerequisite course) is a co-requisite requirement for students who are accepted into the Traditional Nursing Program. It is required for SWIC students that BIOL 157 and BIOL 158 be taken at the same institution.

Additional Information:

- If earning an AA/AS, students may still need an additional three years at SIUE to complete all the BSN requirements.
- All science courses must be completed within 7 years of admission to the program.
