The first project will explore health behaviors in children during and after the COVID-19 pandemic. Objectives include examining which of the child's health behaviors were most impacted by the pandemic, whether the child has returned to pre-pandemic diet and activity levels, and additional projects such as analysis of proper coding and counseling by pediatric health providers.

A second project will explore the impact on water filters on malnutrition in children in Guatemala.
