### Brief description of the nature of the research/creative activity?

Climate risk exposure and Bank Holding Company (BHC) Organizational Complexity

This project studies the relationship between BHC organizational complexity and climate risk exposure of borrowers in syndicated loans market. The hypotheses are:

It is expected that banks with greater organizational complexity may struggle to efficiently process soft information related to climate risk exposure, thus experiencing higher exposure to climate risk.

Alternatively, banks with higher organizational complexity tend to be larger and can allocate more resources to technology and research, which can facilitate the processing of hard information associated with climate change. This may lead to lower information asymmetry and lower exposure to climate risk.

# Brief description of student responsibilities?
