- This is for the Campus Climate Project, a longitudinal study of sexual violence perpetration and victimization on campus. We are in the third cycle, currently in the process of data entry from the around 750 in-person student responses collected last semester. We plan on moving into the analysis and write-up phase of the project this coming year. Potential topics for the manuscript focus may be: rates of reported sexual violence, rates of IPV, rape myth acceptance, sexual violence education, etc.

**Brief description of student responsibilities?**

- Assist with data cleaning
- Assist with results interpretation and discussion

- Assist with manuscript writing, focus on literature searching and writing for literature review
