Brief description of the nature of the research/creative activity?

This URCA activity seeks a student assistant to work with a Art and Design faculty member in their professional art studio practice. The student assistant will learn a variety of skills in traditional ceramic processes (mold-making, materials testing, and kiln firing) and digital tools (digital plotter/cutter, Adobe suite software, and website design). The URCA student will also gain valuable experience with the professional practice of exhibiting artwork (packing and shipping, communication, applications, and documentation).

The URCA student will gain insight on honing their technical craft, maintaining a content-driven creative process, and a developing a clear aesthetic vision under the mentorship of a more experienced artist. The abilities and information gained during this URCA activity can be brought toward the student's own creative practice as an artist.
