## Brief description of the nature of the research/creative activity?

The student will assist with one or more ongoing projects examining factors that influence student success and well-being in higher education. Possible projects include (1) a study exploring belonging, involvement, and sense of community among students within the Department of Applied Health, and/or (2) a physical activity intervention study investigating how movement breaks and daily activity patterns relate to perceived academic control and academic performance. Both projects use a combination of survey and objective data (e.g., Qualtrics surveys, accelerometer or wearable data) to understand behavioral and psychosocial contributors to academic outcomes.

#### **Brief description of student responsibilities?**

Students will be involved in all aspects of the research projects including (but not limited to): conducting literature reviews, participant recruitment, data collection, data analysis, abstract/manuscript preparation, and submission/presentation of abstract at regional and/or national conferences. All activities will be conducted under the supervision of Dr. Vanderbunt and, if applicable, in collaboration with graduate research assistants.
